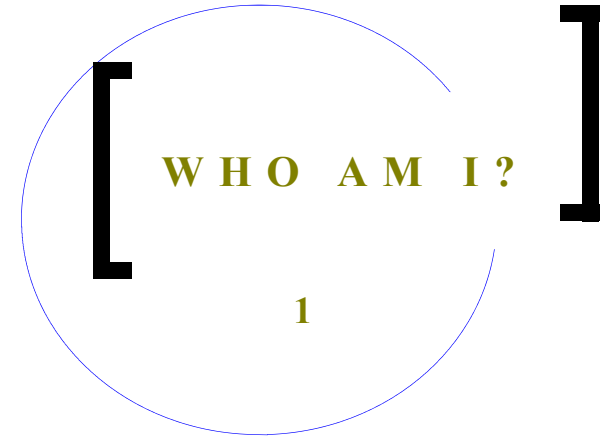

Who I am as a Christian:

(Part one)

Because you are in Christ, every one of these characteristics is completely true of you, and there's nothing you can do to make them less or more true.

But you can make these traits more meaningful and productive in your life by simply believe what God has said about you. One of the greatest ways to help you grow into maturity in Christ is to continually remind yourself who you are in Him. Read the list above twice a week and out aloud. Get your Bible and look up and memorise the scriptures that prompt your particular attention, they will be the ones the Holy Spirit knows you need. Read them when you think Satan is trying to deceive you into thinking you are a useless failure and not doing enough to be sure of your salvation. The more you reaffirm who you are in Christ, the more your behaviour will begin to reflect your true identity. Since you are a saint in Christ by God's calling, you share in His inheritance. **That which is true of Christ is now true of you**, because you are *in* Christ. It is very much part of who you really are as a Christian and a child of God.

- I am the salt of the earth (Matthew 5:13). I am the light of the world (Matthew 5:14).
- **I am a child of God** (John 1:12).
- I am a friend of Christ (John 15:15).
- I am a part of the true vine, a channel of Christ's life (John 15:1,5).
- I am chosen and appointed by Christ to bear His fruit (John 15:16).

- I am a slave of righteousness (Romans 6:18).
- I am enslaved to God (Romans 6:22).
- **I am a son of God**; God is spiritually my Father (Romans 8:14-15, Gal 3:26,4:6).
- I am a joint heir with Christ, sharing His inheritance with Him (Romans 8:17)
- I am a temple of the Holy Spirit and a dwelling place for God (1 Cor 3:16,6:19).
- I am united to the Lord and am one spirit with Him (1 Corinthians 6:17).
- I am a member of Christ's Body (1 Corinthians 12:27; Ephesians 5:30).
- **I am a new creation** (1 Corinthians 5:17).
- I am reconciled to God and am a minister of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:18-19).
- I am a son of God and one in Christ (Galatians 3:26-28).
- I am an heir of God since I am a son of God (Galatians 4:6-7).
- **I am a saint** (Ephesians 1:1; 1 Corinthians 1:2; Philippians 1:1; Colossians 1:2).
- I am God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works (Ephesians 2:10).
- I am a fellow citizen with the rest of God's family (Ephesians 2:19).
- **I am hidden with Christ in God** (Colossians 3:3).
- I am to appear with Christ in glory when He returns (Colossians 3:4).
- I am chosen of God, holy and dearly loved (Colossians 3:12; 1 Thessalonians 1:4).
- I am a son of light and not of darkness (1 Thessalonians 5:5).
- I am a holy partaker of a heavenly calling (Hebrews 3:1).
- I am one of God's living stones, being built up in a spiritual house (1 Peter 2:5).
- **I am a king and a priest and I shall reign on the earth** (Revelation 5:10).
- I am an alien and a stranger to this world (1 Peter 2:11).
- I am an enemy of the devil (1 Peter 5:8).
- I shall be like Christ and see Him as He is when He comes (1 John 3:2).
- I am born of God and the evil one [the devil] cannot touch me (1 John 5:18).
- **I am not the great 'I am'** (Exodus 3:14; John 8:24,28,58), **but by the grace of God, I am what I am** (1 Corinthians 15:10).
